Evaluation of Future Collections Based Volunteering Proposal

The vital curatorial role of Ludlow Museum Resource Centre, which is at the heart of Shropshire Museums, would not be possible without volunteer support. Their time and dedication to our work ensures that we can continue providing a high standard of collections care.

Following a period of change to the staffing and structure of the Ludlow Museum Resource Centre, a proposal paper was made available to volunteers for comment (see appendix 1). The report below outlines the main concerns for volunteers.

Proposed Changes to Volunteer Hours

The majority of volunteers felt at Ludlow Museum Resource Centre felt that the new arrangements were workable and would meet their needs. Tuesday volunteers have been contacted in writing to ensure that any concerns they may have about proposed changes to their volunteering are considered. The loss of opportunities to volunteer at Ludlow on a Tuesday does not appear to cause any real issues.

Restricting curatorial volunteering at Shrewsbury Museum and Art Gallery to a Tuesday has resulted in a loss of some volunteers but it is hoped that with additional staff support available on that day that volunteering can be built up again successfully. This process has already started and a number of new projects are due to start at the end of June.

Communication

Communication between staff and volunteers and between the volunteers as a group was an issue raised by a number of Ludlow volunteers. It is proposed that email groups are established to ensure that:

- Volunteers can be contacted about any immediate changes to volunteering provision such as the Resource Centre being closed due to staff illness.
- All volunteers can be notified of news and key information.

It is also proposed that a group such as a private Facebook group is created to allow volunteers to catch up and discuss their volunteering experiences and issues. Following the success Shrewsbury Museum and Art Gallery Volunteer Facebook page, it has been agreed that this group will be opened to Ludlow volunteers as there is some overlap in both volunteers and information required. Invitations to join have already been circulated to Ludlow volunteers with an email address.

Communications with volunteers without email access will continue via volunteer noticeboards at Ludlow and Shrewsbury.

Training

Both Shrewsbury and Ludlow volunteers have raised the need for more training opportunities. Training on ADLIB has been requested and updates on other training opportunities as they arise.

When do the new arrangements come into place?

It is anticipated that curatorial staff will have to take a break from managing volunteers over the July / August period due to the fit out of the Buttercross for the new Ludlow Museum. Following this break volunteering will restart in September under the new structure.

Will LLMRC continue to have a natural sciences specialist after November?

Yes – Shropshire Council is committed to continuing to employ two curators: one with an archaeology/social history specialism (4 days) and one with a geology/biology specialism (3 days).

Will cover be available during staff sickness and annual leave?

We will do our very best to ensure that cover is available whenever possible but there will be times when staff cannot cover staff absences due to commitments at other museum sites or sudden illness. Will try to ensure that we are able to keep you informed as soon as possible of any breaks in the volunteering programme.

Appendix 1

Future Collections Based Volunteering

As many of you are aware our Heritage Lottery funded 'Volunteering for Shropshire's Heritage' project has ended at a time when Shropshire Museums has to remodel its services to make substantial savings. Therefore, we will be unable to maintain the volunteering opportunities at their previous level but have been working hard to try and find ways to mitigate against the current situation. We have been working closely with the Heritage Lottery Fund and Arts Council to find a way forward. We would now welcome your comments and opinions on our plans as we want to ensure that the new model of operation meets your needs as well as those of the Museum Service.

Where and when can I volunteer?

Collections based volunteering will be available at our two key museum sites:

- *Ludlow Museum Resource Centre – 3 days per week (Monday, Wednesday and Friday)*
- *Shrewsbury Museum and Art Gallery – 1 day per week (Tuesdays)*

What collections can I work on?

Each volunteering day will focus on a specific type of collection. This will depend upon on which collections are held at that site and which specialist curator will be available to oversee the volunteering session and give specialist support. More general database and collection documentation work will be available most days.

On Monday and Fridays Ludlow Museum Resource Centre will focus upon opportunities to work on the natural science collections. On Wednesdays the emphasis will shift to the archaeology and social history collections.

On Tuesdays Shrewsbury Museum and Art Gallery will offer opportunities to work on the decorative art and fine art collections.

What tasks can I undertake?

We will be identifying key collections which we need volunteers to work on. One key issue for the service is the need to address our collection documentation backlog. We still have over 200,000 object records which need to be digitised. Therefore, our emphasis will move from research towards addressing the need for data entry onto the collection management database.

Therefore, we will ask volunteers to work individually or in small teams to work through various tasks required for specific collections:

- Creating and updating basic collections database catalogue records which can be reviewed by specialists.
- Researching specific objects and /or collections and adding this new data to our collections database catalogue.
- Photographing items which do not have images on the collections database.
- Reorganising stores, removing and returning objects required for exhibitions or education sessions and repacking objects if required.
